The sessions present age-appropriate curriculum and are designed to provide students with engaging educational activities that are both informative and entertaining.

THEMES:

Monday, March 16: Brain Games – Investigate the ins and outs of the human brain as you explore anatomy; participate in sensory science challenges; create optical illusions; and try out brain teasers in memory, math, and logic.

Tuesday, March 17: Shamrock Science – It's a St. Patrick's Day themed camp of discovery! Create a density rainbow, decipher code to find hidden treasure, use chemistry to polish "gold," and design and construct a lucky Leprechaun trap.

Wednesday, March 18: Fab Food Lab – Enjoy a day exploring science with a fabulous food twist. Discover digestion in a goo-ology experiment, engineer spaghetti towers, and concoct some edible and not-so-edible treats!

Thursday, March 19: Spring Fling – Celebrate the first day of spring with some super seasonal science experiments! Myth-bust if an egg will really stand on its head, dissect a flower, investigate seed science, plant a mini-garden, and explore nature on an eco-stroll.

Friday, March 20: Potions Class – Professor Snape has left a challenging set of lesson plans for magicians and muggles attending today's session. Get hands-on mixing an assortment of chemistry concoctions that ooze, bubble, and burst!

Monday, March 23: Spark Smorgasbord – Wrap up the spring camp session with an exciting assortment of all things STEAM. Anything goes in a camp that's all about fun, hands-on discoveries!
