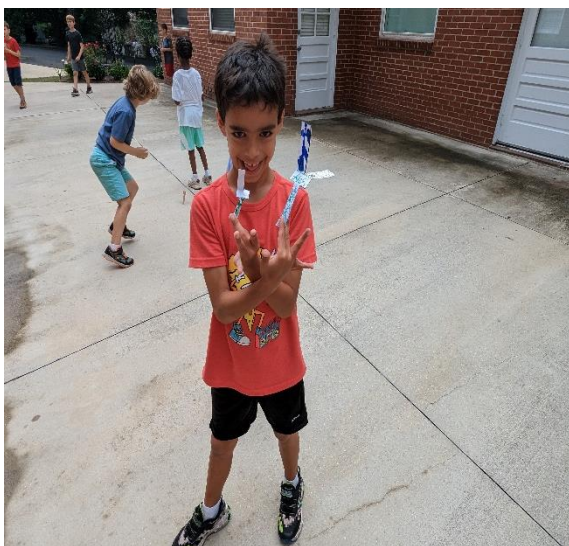


Mr. Ethan's Robotics

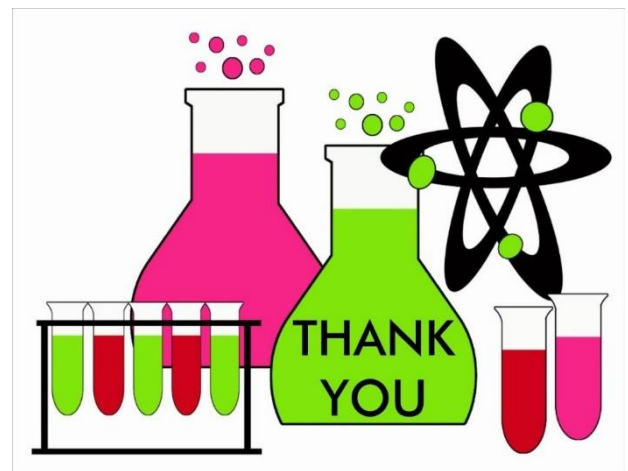
