Savory Science

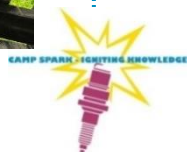


Ms. Caroline 2 – 4

Ms. Emma's 5-8 Boom and Pop Art

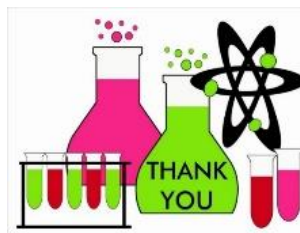


MoLab Hopes Everyone had a Fun and Safe 4th of July Holiday!
