Monday, December 23: Nano Science – Enjoy experiments that investigate the power of extremely tiny things. Build with candy to understand nano-sized technologies, get hands-on with chemistry, explore scale, and discover nano in nature!

Friday, December 27: Candy Coated Chemistry – Bust out your lab coats and get ready for a sensationally sweet day exploring candy science. Build with and explode marshmallows, explore phase changes with chocolate, and erupt a candy volcano!

Monday, December 30: Engineer Force - It's a day dedicated to engineering and design! You'll have fun with creative projects including constructing a cork launcher, building paper super structures, and making your own marble maze!

Tuesday, December 31: Science Celebrations – Let's celebrate 2024 by exploring some of this year's amazing breakthroughs! Blackhole gravity experiments, candy DNA, and dino-discoveries galore!

Thursday, January 2: Frozen Physics - Brrr, 'tis the season to experiment with chilly, frosty, and freezing things! Explore phase changes, enjoy dry ice experiments, and concoct your own frozen treat as you discover the science of all things cold!

Friday, January 3: Inside Out Science – Oh joy, there are so many fun ways to explore the science of the human brain! Participate in sensory science challenges and optical illusions, paint your emotions plus, brain teasers in memory, math, and logic.
