Spring Camp Spark will offer students 5 years old through the 8th grade the opportunity to participate in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) activities in a fun, interactive, and safe environment. Each daily session will present campers the opportunity to explore science through creative play, experimentation, and inquiry-based learning experiences. The sessions present age-appropriate curriculum and are designed to provide students with engaging educational activities that are both informative and entertaining.

THEMES:

Monday, March 10: Engineer Lab – You are the engineer as you get hands-on with fun challenges that have you thinking creatively to solve problems while building 3D designs. Build a bridge, create a Lego shelter, and use your imagination to construct from a mystery bag!

Tuesday, March 11: Sweet Science – Get hands-on experimenting with the sweet side of science! Taste test with jellybeans, discover density with chocolate bars, engineer with Twizzlers, and concoct some edible and not-so-edible treats!!

Wednesday, March 12: Matter Mysteries – Use your science investigation skills to explore the properties of anything that takes up space. Crush, Fizz, Boom - get hands-on and experiment with cool chemical reactions and fabulous physical changes.

Thursday, March 13: Brain Games – Investigate the ins and outs of the human brain as you explore anatomy; participate in sensory science challenges; create optical illusions; and try out brain teasers in memory, math, and logic.

Friday, March 14: Bug-O-Rama – Enjoy a day of entomological fun exploring the microworld of our favorite insects! Discover the science behind cute critters that engineer, stink, pollinate, and glow.

Monday, March 17: Shamrock Science – It's a St. Patrick's Day themed camp of discovery! Create a density rainbow, decipher code to find hidden treasure, use chemistry to polish “gold,” and design and construct a lucky Leprechaun trap.

FEES:

Daily Camp fees are \$58 per day. Register more than one camper and all additional siblings receive a discounted rate of \$53 per day.

Hours are from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; drop off starts at 8:45 a.m. and pick up is until 4:15 p.m.

Extended Camp care is available starting at 7:45 a.m. for \$5/day and until 6 p.m. for \$5/day.
