The sessions present age-appropriate curriculum and are designed to provide students with engaging educational activities that are both informative and entertaining.

Monday, December 21: Winter Wonders – Celebrate the winter solstice with cool experiments and crafts. Enjoy frosty and freezing experiments, explore the Northern Lights, discover animals that love the chill, and make your own ice cream as you explore the science of the season – brrr!

Tuesday, December 22: Matter Mysteries – Get hands-on and use your observational skills to investigate the properties of matter. Concoct slimy mixtures, use chemistry to create a gas, build an edible molecule model. Anything goes when you're having fun exploring matter!

Wednesday, December 23: Candy Constructions – It's bound to be a sticky situation when we use candy to explore physics. Enjoy fun hands-on projects that include building marshmallow launchers, engineering Twizzler rope bridges, and exploring phase changes to make candy cane ornaments.

Monday, December 28: Volcanoes! – It's an explosive day of discovery exploring the dynamic Earth. Enjoy fun experiments with volcanic eruptions, gushing geysers, edible plate tectonics, and create lava goop!

Tuesday, December 29: Camp Avengers – Assemble to explore the science behind superheroes! Get hands-on with Black Panther's supermaterials, discover how polymers help Spiderman spin his web, explore force and momentum with Captain America. Plus, experiment with electricity in Thor's Lightning Lab!

Wednesday, December 30: Glow Science – So many things glow in the dark! From toys to nature, we will explore things that give off their own light. Experiment with glow sticks, explode an eerie geyser, and create glow in the dark slime!

Thursday, December 31: NYExtravaganza! – It's a day of festive discovery as we celebrate the end of 2026 and welcome a New Year! Build confetti launchers, create colorful liquid fireworks, use chemistry in fizzing experiments, engineer a ball drop, and more!

Monday, January 4: Spark Smorgasbord – Let's conclude another exciting session of Camp Spark with an assortment of your favorite STEAM activities. The possibilities are endless with experiments in chemistry, physics fun, food science, and so much more!
